Mechanics for PPGEIC - UP Diliman

Category A: Science Project Competition for College of Science Students

Primary Requirements:

- a) The project should involve a product, process, or technology in any Science field. The project should have the potential to be transformed into a business.
- b) The students must be from the College of Science from UP Diliman.

Category B: Engineering Project Competition for College of Engineering Students.

Primary Requirements:

- a) The project should involve a product, process, or technology in the Engineering field. The project should have the potential to be transformed into a business.
- b) The students must be from the College of Engineering from UP Diliman.

Category C: Business Project Competition for College of Business Administration and School of Economics Students

Primary Requirements:

- a) The project should involve a product, process, or technology in any field. The project should have the potential to be transformed into a business.
- b) The students must be from the College of Business Administration or the School of Economics or both from UP Diliman.

Category D (Special): Business Project Competition for College of Business Administration and School of Economics Students involving a technology in the Engineering or Science fields.

- a) The project should involve a product, process, or technology in the Science or Engineering field. The project should have the potential to be transformed into a business.
- b) The students must be from the College of Business Administration or the School of Economics or both, from UP Diliman. Optionally, students from the Colleges of Science or Engineering may join this team. However, the team must not be composed of entirely Science and Engineering Students.

Secondary Requirements for all Categories

1. Each team may be composed of one or several members. The number of members is not restricted. The number of entries a team may send is unlimited. The only requirement is that each of the undergraduate, graduate, or post-graduate student members, should at least be enrolled in the University of the Philippines, Diliman, at least a full semester before January 11, 2010.

2. Each team is required to submit a two sheets per entry.

The first sheet contains the name, postal address(es), telephone number(s), age, year-level, college and course, and a 1-3 sentence writeup about each member. There is no restriction on the margin, font-size, font-type, nor font-color on the first sheet.

The second sheet is the project description itself.

You may put anything on the second sheet. There is no restriction on the margin, font-size, the font-type, font-color, nor the number of images and diagrams in the second sheet.

The only restrictions on each of the two sheets is that they should be of A4 or Letter size in PDF or .doc format, if sent via mail, or on a white bond paper, of A4 or Letter size, enclosed in a brown envelope, if mailed to our P.O. BOX. Email submissions with the .docx format and other formats will not be accepted.

The "subject line" of the email, should be:

Emails with subjects other than the prescribed one will not be accepted.

Schedule

First round: Deadline of submissions for the first round would be on January 11, 2010.

Second round: Qualifiers for the first round would be announced on February 8, 2010. Qualifiers would be contacted via phone and email and would be briefed on the requirements so they could prepare for a 10-minute panel presentation of their project(s) on March 8, 2010. (Venue: UP Diliman)

Third round: Qualifiers for the second round would then present their funding requirements to the actual project funders on April 12, 2010. (Venue: Pinoy Pilgrim Foundation Global Foundation, Inc. Headquarters)
